



Whether you're a Tot or advanced level skater, we want YOU to be a part of our Spring Ice Show! It's as easy as 1...2...3! Here's how...

One! Students will need to be enrolled in Session 2 (Winter) and Session 3 (Spring) of Skating School group classes in 2021.

TWO! Register by March 22nd, being sure to submit your costume size & full payment. Included in your fee will be: rehearsal time, professional choreography & a quality costume. You may need to provide small costume accessories such as tights, gloves, boot covers, etc.

Three! Attend your scheduled group rehearsals, run-thru, dress rehearsal and perform in all three shows. The tentative rehearsal schedule is included in the following pages. Check it carefully before registering for the show so you know if you can attend. Consistent participation during rehearsals is extremely important.

What do I register for? Your current Session 2 (Winter) class = your ice show group. Skaters who are enrolled in our Specialty classes are invited to sign up for *more than* one ice show number (see rehearsal schedule to find out what additional #'s you qualify for).

Make sure we have your email! Any changes or additions to the schedule will be emailed to you, along with important instructions as we get closer to run-thru, dress rehearsal and show days. These will also be posted on the Ice Show page of our website.

Covid-19 Information: We anticipate that Covid-19 restrictions will still be in place when Spring Ice Show takes place. We will run the show in accordance with local & state protocols at that given time. Prepare for limited guest capacity seating as well as any other scenarios that may be necessary at the time.

Competitive Skaters Only - These spotlight numbers in our show are to recognize those Franklin Park skaters who compete as individuals within the ISI or USFS organizations. Skaters must have participated in 2 competitions this season.

Eligibility for registration: Skater must have participated in a competition since October 2020 or be registered for an event thru April of 2021 and be presently tested at the ISI Beta or above and/or USFS Pre-Preliminary FS Level. Must be ISI tested for the competitive or elite numbers. Note: Group levels may be rearranged dependent on enrollment.
